SyracuseCoE's LEED Platinum facility at 727 E. Washington Street in Syracuse is a living lab for energy-efficient building technologies, offering testbed opportunities to develop and demonstrate the latest advances in real-world and simulated conditions.

Since 2002, SyracuseCoE has funded 600+ research, development, and demonstration projects, as well as fellowships and internships, resulting in nearly 1,650 jobs created and retained, 88 patents and licenses, and 17 new start-up companies. In addition, SyracuseCoE has assisted its stakeholders in leveraging nearly \$225 million in additional R&D funding and investment.
