CONFERENCE PROFILE

The 2027 Healthy Buildings America Conference is a flagship international conference of the International Society of Indoor Air Quality (ISIAQ) and will be held in Syracuse, NY, USA, on June 20 – 23, 2027, hosted by Syracuse University and SyracuseCoE – New York State Center of Excellence in Environmental and Energy Systems.

The theme of the 2027 Healthy Buildings America Conference is "Intelligent Environments: Designing, Retrofitting and Operating for a Healthy, Affordable and Resilient Future." The conference will gather international researchers, engineers, designers, and policymakers to share insights on both cutting-edge new buildings and transformative retrofitting of existing spaces.

Keynotes and sessions will highlight scalable, effective and efficient technologies, collaborative community-driven design methods and practices, and policy pathways to healthier indoor environments across all building types and communities.

The conference will cover a wide range of research topics cutting across multiple scales of built environmental systems, including:

- AI Applications in Healthy Buildings
- Smart Health Monitoring & Control
- Advanced & Sustainable Materials
- Retrofit & Resilience Strategies
- Intelligent New Building Design & Life Cycle Analysis
- Community-Scale Intelligence & Public Health
- Occupant Behavior, Health, & Wellness in Buildings

The goal of the conference is to advance intelligent, future-ready solutions to the converging challenges of climate change, public health disparities, aging infrastructure, and rising construction costs.

CITY AND VENUE

The 2027 Healthy Buildings America Conference, hosted by Syracuse University and SyracuseCoE, will take place in Syracuse, New York, a small city in Upstate New York known for its expertise in indoor air quality and environmental and energy systems. The conference will be held at the Marriott Syracuse Downtown, formerly known as the Hotel Syracuse, a grand historic hotel originally opened in 1924 and restored to its former grand opulence. It is located near Syracuse's historic Armory Square, a popular shopping and dining district in the heart of the city.

AUDIENCE

The 2027 Healthy Buildings America Conference offers an international platform for researchers, practitioners, architects, engineers, and educators, as well as students who are involved in built environmental systems to share research results with the broader buildings community.

FORMAT

The 2027 Healthy Buildings America Conference will begin on Sunday, June 20, 2027, with a Welcome Reception at the Marriott Syracuse Downtown. The technical program will include keynote presentations in plenary sessions, as well as a full schedule of parallel and poster sessions.

Keynote speakers and parallel sessions will be featured on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday. Evening events include a reception at SyracuseCoE headquarters (a LEED Platinum research testbed) on Monday, June 21, as well as the conference social hour and dinner in the Grand Ballroom at the Marriott Syracuse Downtown on Tuesday, June 22. Closing Ceremonies will be held mid-day on Wednesday, June 23, followed by post-conference activities.
